

HEDLEY ON THE HILL PARISH COUNCIL

Minutes of the meeting held on 10th October 2016 at 8.30pm in the Feathers' Inn

(The Council meeting followed a Village meeting to discuss Item9 on the Agenda)

636. **Apologies:** None

637. **Declarations of Interest:** None

638: **Minutes of the meeting of 12th September 2016:** These were approved.

639: **Matters arising not elsewhere on the agenda:**

- a) An extra map of footpaths etc. had been obtained from County Hall which would be kept with the Council's documents by the Clerk
- b) It was not known if the speeding through the village had been measured yet and the Clerk would chase this up
- c) The plaque for the hitching posts was not yet ready
- d) No further response had been received from the library service about the replacement van.

640. **Planning:**

15/04313/FUL – Conversion of outbuildings to residential at Woodhead Farm, Newlands –
Still unclear as to final status;

16/00195/ENFCOU – update: In a reply from the enforcement officer, it was noted that Planners were still awaiting an application for this venture relating to both the building and the signs. Another officer was now dealing with the matter and Cllr Horncastle agreed to mention the matter when he next talked with him. It was also noted that Mr Clarke had emailed all councillors.

16/00195/PREAPP – Storage units at Glider Club – still pending

641: **County Councillor report:** Cllr Horncastle has arranged a meeting for Councillors and officers from the County to walk round the village. This was successfully undertaken with Kris Westerby from the West office of NCC attending. He agreed that the deepest holes on West Hill would be repaired; white lines would be put on the edges of the road; some drainage work would be undertaken and as a trial after painting a mid - road line, adhesive cat's eyes would be trialled on the road to Currock Hill. The Highways Inspector has to visit

first then a programme can be worked out with a time table. It was thought that some pavements could be repaired but not all.

642: **Correspondence:** this was noted

643. **Possible Community hall:** Following the response to flyers, a Village Meeting on the matter was held prior to the Council meeting. Brief notes of this are appended to the Minutes. It was also noted that the Clerk had asked the County Council's legal team to see if they can find out about the easement across the Village Green apparently outstanding from 2004.

644. **A – Boards Consultation by NCC:** As a rural community there was little in their proposed guidelines. However it was agreed to forward a request that more be added to the guidelines relating to A-boards and signage in very rural roads where it could present a danger.

645. **Finance:**

a) The Bank of Scotland had apparently 'not got' the Councillors signatures on their records and had requested new mandates be filled out before acting on the Council's instructions. This was done;

b) The current balance on the account before today's payments is £2350.00. This includes the second tranche of precept and a VAT rebate from the previous financial year.
