Childsmile 16th April

The Childsmile ladies will be coming to nursery to apply the fluoride varnish. Only those who have returned written consent will have the varnish applied.

Easter Parade/Egg Hunt 18th April

As part of our Easter celebration we will be having our Easter parade to show off all your handy work from your homemade Easter Bonnets. There will be 1st, 2nd and 3rd prizes for the best bonnets. We will also be having our Easter egg hunt.

Visits to Dunollie Grounds.

We have booked transport every Friday morning for 6 weeks, starting on the 10th May, to take the morning group to explore the grounds of Dunollie House and surrounding areas. We will be going no matter what the weather, unless it is deemed dangerous. So please remember to dress for the weather. Some weeks that will be wellies. and others will be sun cream and sunhats!

Highlands and Island Music festival:

We are delighted to be back at the festival this year after missing it because of our inspection last year! The morning children will attend on Friday 3rd May, they should arrive as normal to nursery, where we will have a bus to take us to the Corran Halls (hopefully, as we can't book until we have our time slot). Family and friends are welcome to come along and cheer us on, there will mostly be a small entry fee to watch. We will have a return bus to bring us back to nursery, however, if you prefer to collect from the Corran Halls that will be fine too. We do ask that you are patient with staff when collecting children as all schools/nurseries in the area are invited to attend and it is very busy. Usual sign out/password policies will apply. Child safety will be our priority.

Outdoor classroom day: Transition visit to Stramash.

This has become an annual event where all the nurseries come together at the Stramash site and share in activities based around our shared Transition topic for the children moving on to school. (more details to come after the topic is introduced to the children). Pick up and drop off will be as normal for the children, we have arranged transport to get to and from the site.

Charities day: 1st June

We have 2 stalls this year, one for Project and one for Nursery, so we need volunteers from both sides to help on the day. No child can attend without a completed consent form, so you must make sure you return it before the date on the form. Morning group children will travel out by train, afternoon group children will travel by bus, all this information is in the consent form, please read it carefully, and keep the information sheet at home, we only need the signed consent at the back.

Please pay particular attention to the return bus travel, and only request a space for your child if they definitely need it, this helps us keep costs down.

Consent forms will go into trays when we return after the holidays.
