18/1 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE and declarations of interest.

There we no Apologies for Absence. There were no declarations of interest.

18/2 TO CONFIRM THE MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON 20TH NOVEMBER 2017

The minutes had been circulated prior to the meeting and were unanimously confirmed as a true and correct record and signed by the chairman.

18/3 PUBLIC FORUM.

A resident reported that he had pressurised NYCC Highways to repair potholes in Mill Lane. Water on the road surface at Arden Bridge is causing a hazard when it freezes. The clerk will report to NYCC.

18/4 PLANNING APPLICATIONS FOR CONSIDERATION, HDC decisions.

18/7 FINANCIAL MATTERS.

Cllr Atkinson presented the current financial position:

- 2. Payments since last meeting: £135 August & September grass cutting, £15 hall hire, £45 pop-up-pub.

- 3. The bank balance at 31st January 2018 was £4,853.76. Cheque 303 for £250 still to be banked by Thirsk Community Library.
- 4. Bills due for payment: £10.40 salt shovels, £15 hall hire, £45 pop-up-pub.
- 5. The 2017/18 costings were considered to be within the available funds.
- 6. It was confirmed that the Precept for 2018/19 will be £2000.

18/8 REPORTS FROM PARISH COUNCILLORS

- 1. Mill Lane: problems with surface water and mud on the road. Reported to NYCC for action.
- 2. **Mill Lane:** tree branches left on corner of junction by BT during line clearing. Reported to Hambleton for action.
- 3. **Litter on the roadsides has increased over the last six months.** Temporary signage may help.
- Salt Grit Bin on Village Green damaged. Consider replacing next autumn.
- Footpath from Village Green to Little Thirkleby in poor condition. Cllrs Turner & Atkinson to seek prices to resurface the path with gravel three feet wide.
- 6. Possible keep-fit / Pilates classes in the Village Hall. Cllr Turner to make enquiries.
