Rules

1. Entry Fee 50p per exhibit, on entering.
Section 6 'Young Talent' ENTRY FREE
2. **Entries accepted between 9:00am-11:00am ONLY**
Doors locked immediately after, for judging to Commence. Reopening at 2pm.
3. A limit of two entries per class per exhibitor.
4. All vegetables, flowers and fruit in all classes to be grown by the competitor.
5. All baking done from scratch.
6. All handicrafts to have been worked in the last 12 months.
7. All photographs to have been taken in the last 12 months.
8. Children's crafts must be the child's own work.
9. Children's classes to have been worked in the last 12 months.
10. Certificates awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place.
11. Produce/exhibits to remain in the hall until 4:00pm, if possible.
12. Any produce left on the exhibit tables after 4.30pm will be included in the auction at the end of the show.
13. Judge's decision will be final.

- 13 Five shallots
- 14 One capsicum pepper

- 17 One seed tray not exceeding 18"x12" of four mixed vegetables, one of each variety (may be garnished)
- 18 One any other vegetable not mentioned above
