Battle Trust and ELC development proposal for mining museum

Fiona King a consultant on behalf of the battle trust came to tell us more about the proposal. Her intentions was that they have to engage with the community, so she brought questionnaires for us to be filled in.

The Battle Trust and ELC are looking to formulate a Heritage Lottery funding application to develop the mining museum bath house to house the tapestry.

Through the discussion we established that there deadline for applying is February. They were doing their public consultation now to be completed before Christmas with their questionnaire. Concerns were raised even with the construction of questions. Concerns were raised about the lack of involvement from the community from the beginning before the questionnaire was created, and that the community cannot be used as a box ticking activity on applications. We made it clear that we need to be involved from the very beginning.

Fiona was keen to work with us as they need the community on board for the application to be successful with the Heritage Lottery Fund.
