8.1 Ethol Cynghorwyr Cymuned. Roedd Candice a Mari wedi paratoi llythyr a cafodd y llythyrau eu darllen allan. Cytunwyd yn unfrydol y dylai'r ddwy gael eu hethol i fod yn gynghorwyr. Arwyddwyd dogfen datganiad o dderbyn swydd gan y ddwy.			8.1 Election of Community Councillors. Mari and Candice had prepared a letter which was read out to Councillors. It was agreed unanimously that both Mari and Candice be co-opted as a Councillor. Both signed a declaration of acceptance of office.

8.6 Panel 'Brenig Wind' – Mae Cadwyn Clwyd wedi hysbysebu am wirfoddolwyr i eistedd ar panel y gronfa Brenig Wind, sydd yn debygol o dalu allan tua £150,000 y flwyddyn. Cafwyd trafodaeth am y byr rybydd i hel panel at ei gilydd (dyddiad cau 16 o Fedi) a cytunwyd y byddai Paul Marfleet yn ysgrifennu ebost ar ran y Cyngor Cymuned i Cadwyn Clwyd i ddatgan pryder fel isod:-

We are therefore requesting that the Community Council play some part in the decision making with regard to the selection and subsequent appointment of members of the panel, or at the very least, be consulted before final decisions are made.

A discussion took place about the short timescale given (closing date for applications is 16th September), and it was agreed that Paul Marfleet would draft an email on behalf of the Community Council to Cadwyn Clwyd expressing concerns below:-
