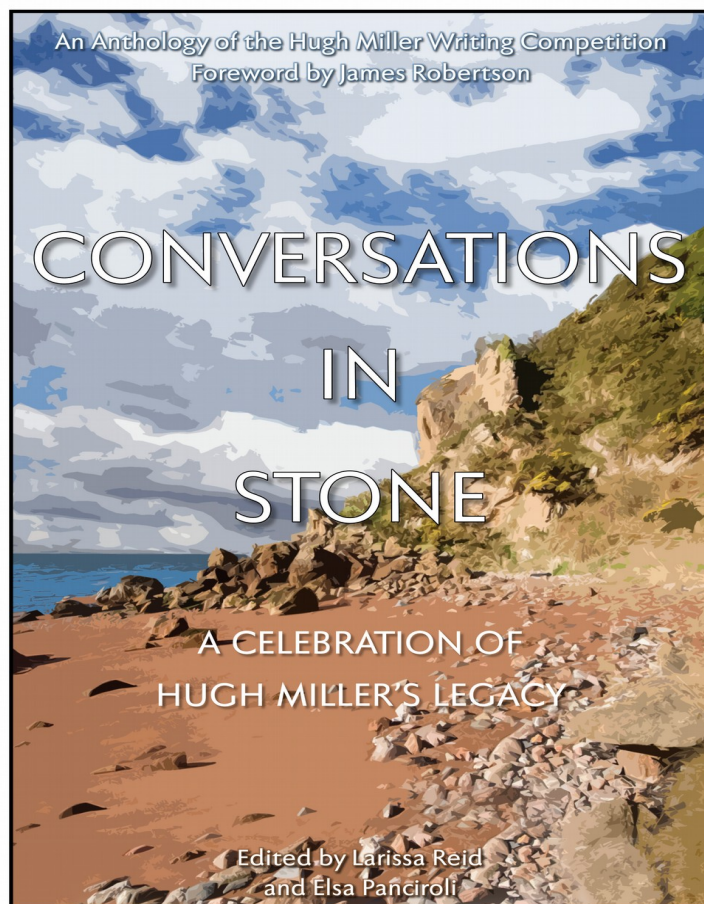

The Scottish Geodiversity Forum, largely at the initiative of executive committee member Lara Reid, has seized the chance of the Dippy on Tour exhibition to further promote the best pieces on geology in prose and poetry which won prizes in the first two Hugh Miller Writing Competitions.

At least four first prize winners will be reciting their pieces in the Discovery Room, which can seat 50, with plenty of room for standing, so all those who have not heard these inspirational writings performed live should most definitely come along.

Lara will also be introducing publicly the Hugh Miller legacy booklet, *Conversations in Stone* which she has co-edited with palaeontologist Ms Elsa Panciroli, and announcing the launching in the Autumn of the third, 2019/20 Writing Competition.
