

Minute of Beauly Community Council Meeting held at Phipps Hall on Monday the 28th September 2015 at 7PM.

1. Minute of Previous meeting (78) held on the 31st August was read and approved by Jane Campbell and seconded by Seona Fraser.

Yvonne Ross from Beauly Football Club attended to update the BCC regarding the placement of their portacabin, after discussion with Iain Shepherd at Lovat Estates its proposed to place it at the rear of the Phipps Hall near the old tennis courts.

2. Police Report - PC Jones attended to address concerns raised regarding the dangerous dog and Road Traffic issues within the village. The owner of the dog does have an order against him that states he must have the dog under control at all times. And that all incidents should be reported to the police at the time so they could be dealt with. The various road traffic concerns regarding speeding, safety of school children and parking were also discussed. PC Jones suggested that if Councillor Carmichael could find the figures from the last survey and forward them to him he would pass the information onto the Road Policing Unit and make them aware of the other road traffic concerns, with the intention of working together with local officers to address these issues. **Anti Social Behaviour** - Vulnerable male was arrested for ASB with neighbours in Croyard Court, Police are working with Highland council housing officers to reduce potential for any further issues. **Crimes of Dishonesty** - Local Youths were taken home to parents after climbing onto the scaffolding at the Old Priory, several reports were received regarding a male in the Beauly area committing offences of Fraud Board & Lodgings using the names Craig Kerr and Shawn Sinclair, police have a positive line of enquiry regarding this incident.

A. Fountain in the Square - Ongoing - Pump has been removed and a new pump is being sourced and over the winter other repairs such as painting etc will be carried out with the help of the Men in Shed team.

B. Maple Vale Play Park - Ongoing Councillor Carmichael is meeting with the Ward Business Manager and will update the BCC at the next meeting.

C. Wood Carving at Old Priory - Ongoing

D. Remembrance Day Wreath Holders - Have all been made and are to be placed.

E. Bus Shelter/public crossing/path widening - Ongoing - It is hoped this project will move forward in October.

F. Crests on Planters in the Square - Ongoing 14 are required and James Campbell is waiting on a quote from suppliers.
