

## To all residents of Cross and Compton Bishop

As we are sure you will all be aware, as of today all public places have been told to close.

We expect this to be a very challenging time for all of us and we have been thinking of ideas to make life a little bit better for everyone.

After brainstorming a few ideas over the past week or so we would like to run a couple past you to gauge your feedback.

Firstly it has been suggested that due to the supermarkets having a possible 2 week waiting list for delivery of groceries and our ability to still source essential ingredients from our suppliers 6 days a week (at the moment) we could provide a range of products to residents of Cross and Compton Bishop.

These could include:

A full range of fresh fruit and vegetables

Meat from our local butcher, e.g. bacon, sausages, ham, mince, diced meat for stews etc.

Dairy products for example, milk, butter, eggs and cheese

Store cupboard basic

A range of frozen products

Beer, wines, soft drinks and snacks (Obviously)

Another idea would be to run a weekly menu of food nights that we could deliver, such as for example :

### Monday

Cottage pie and peas

### Tuesday

Macaroni cheese with bacon, salad and garlic bread

### Wednesday

Beef stew, mash and dumplings

### Thursday

Curry or chilli con carne with rice

### Friday

Cod and chips with mushy peas

### Saturday

Lasagne, salad and garlic bread

### Sunday

Roast dinner

Everything would be freshly prepared that day and delivered hot to your door between 6-8pm Monday-Saturday and Sunday 1.-3pm. These would need to be pre ordered the previous day.

These are only ideas of meals we could provide at the moment and we would aim to change them weekly. We would welcome suggestions and feedback.

Over the coming days we hope to finalise a product and price list.

At this early stage we are hoping that everyone has enough provisions for the next few days but if anybody does need anything in the meantime please do get in touch and we will be happy to help.
