## Age Groups

1) Players must be over 9 years and under 11 years on September $1^{\text {st }} 2013$.
(i.e. currently in academic years 5 or 6 ).
2) Squads may be of a mixed gender with a maximum of three boys competing.
3) Squads must have a minimum of seven players and a maximum of nine players.

## District Entries

Each School Games Organiser area can send the winner and runner up from local leagues/festivals.
Any team found to be defaulting on any of the above, will be allowed to complete fixtures so that the competition is not spoilt for others, however results from their fixtures will not be recognised.

## Player Rotation:

The appropriate rotation sequence for the squad size must be followed. Spot checks may occur.
Any team found to default on this will have points deducted from their tally.

## Matches \& Scoring:

The competition format will be a 'Round Robin'.
Match duration will be determined by the number of entries.
Points will be awarded after each match as follows:

Winning Team:
Draw:
Losing Team:

5 points
3 points
1 point.

Teams must be on court and ready to start at the scheduled time - failure to comply will result in one goal being awarded to opponents for each minute (or part) that the start is delayed.

England Netball playing rules will be observed throughout - with the exception of injuries:

## Injuries:

- No injury time is allowed during any match.
- Should an injury occur during play, umpires will assess the situation and will either instruct the team manager to deal with the injury at the court side, or if necessary will stop play. If the injury is dealt with at the courtside, the player may rejoin the game or may be substituted after notifying the umpire.
- If the player is substituted, the substitute must remain on court for the remainder of the playing period.
- Should a match need to be stopped by the umpire and play cannot continue, the Tournament Referee will be informed.
- The Tournament Referee will decide whether the score at the time the match was stopped will stand as the final score, or whether the match will be replayed.
