The 'Year of Faith' Begins!

On 11 October all around the world, we will mark the opening of the 'Year of Faith'. This is an invitation from Pope Benedict XVI to all Catholics throughout the world, both as individuals and as members of their various faith communities to focus on their faith so as to deepen their understanding of what it means to have Faith and to live Faith each day. Archbishop Vincent Nichols has asked us to be generous in responding to the Pope's invitation. But we need to remember that, even as we begin this Year of Faith, it is not a year to be celebrated in isolation, since the call to deepen Faith is something that belongs to every year.

I would like to form family cell groups for the launch of the "Year of Faith". Utilising the booklet brought out by the Diocese called "Radiating Christ", I am looking for families interested in hosting home groups. Who attend the groups is entirely left to the discernment of the hosting family. The Archbishop of Westminster is encouraging the use of this booklet within the home — so a cell group may consist of only family members, or it could include couples, or single people, or it could be a gathering of friends, or a mixture. 'Ine Psalms' at the Carmelite Church
