POLICE REPORT

MATTERS ARISING/OUTSTANDING ISSUES/ACTIONS

Braes of Conon – Playpark

There are issues with dog fouling and littering at the new play park.

Real-time bus display – No update.

Noticeboard – There is an Agreement in Principle from Highland Council to put the new noticeboard in between the MUGA and the bus stop. The old notice board will be painted and left in situ. There was discussion about what information should be put on the notice boards, it was agreed that there shouldn't be anything commercial, but information to help the community should be put included e.g. helplines, lunch club info. Suggestions to be forwarded to the Community Council for consideration.

Ladies Walk project – No update.

Defibrillator(s) – It was suggested that the owners of Cafe India be approached to see if they would take the defib when they move into their new premises.

ANY OTHER BUSINESS

Traffic through village – New speed awareness signs have been installed.. Speeding continues to be an issue through the village, cars exceeding 20mph should be referred to the police. There was discussion about large lorries coming through the village, these do have to come this way as there is a weight restriction on the Moy bridge.

Dog fouling – This is an issue throughout the village. There are reports of dogs let out without owners. These can be reported and picked up by dog warden.

Future meetings - Guidance has been issued to Community Councils that meetings should be held virtually for the rest of the year, and 6 meetings a year need to be held to get the grant.
