## **Treasurer's Report, AGM 8 March 2021**

Many thanks to Martin Rowe for examining this year's accounts.

I am pleased to report that most members renewed their subscriptions last year and helped to keep the Club in a stable financial position. As I am sure you are all aware, without membership subscriptions and boat parking fees the Club would struggle to survive financially.

A total of £213.50 was raised from prize money and donations received at this year's GALE Christmas Tree Festival. The winnings were divided between CLIC Sargent and the Highland Hospice.

A donation of £50 was made to the Harbour Lights Appeal.

Thanks to Alison for her donation to the Club of £116 raised from selling her knitted chocolate egg covers.

Many thanks to Gary for looking after the records for the boat park and calculating the fees due.

A new-to-us RIB was purchased from the RYA at a cost of £3000. A welcome addition.

On becoming a Scottish Charitable Incorporated Organisation in September 2020, we applied for water rate relief and a refund of £53.11 was obtained. (This must be applied for every year.)

Funds have been spent on Sars-CoV-2 specific expenses and have included additional cleaning materials to comply with the regulations.

Overall, we sustained a loss of £1797.35.
