ALDENHAM PARK, MORVILLE

A Grade 2 listed Palledian house where Charles I took refuge from Cromwell in a priest hole and left his coat behind. The house is a private family home bought by the present owners in 1959 from the Acton family. The tour takes 2 and a half hours and will be followed by tea/coffee and cakes.
