## Remembrance Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> November 2021

This year we shall hold our Service of Remembrance around the War Memorial, as we have done in previous years, and you will have no doubt seen the commemorative poppies on display during the year – the Flanders Field Poppies planted in the bank and more recently the silhouettes of ‘The Unknown Tommy’, the silhouettes of the animals, the Poppy Waterfall and the tree from Hellfire Corner in Ypres.

We would like to thank all of you who have so very kindly taken the time to contribute to these displays.

This letter is to give you notice that this year we have applied to close the road around the area of the War Memorial for the duration of the service, 10.30 am to 11.15 am whilst the Village congregate and disperse and allowing us to observe the 2-minute silence. We would therefore ask that if you are leaving the village between 10.45am and 11.15am that you leave by a route that does not go through the Churchtown part of our village.

Your understanding and co-operation with this temporary road closure for the duration of the Remembrance Service on the 14<sup>th</sup> of November 2021 is greatly appreciated.
