What part of the design do you really like?

Open space, natural play. Natural play areas, community orchard, sheltered gathering space, SUDs scheme, café and garden. Garden, play areas. Good design and idea, needs refined. Imaginative use of SUDs area, outdoor seating area with shelter, courtyard shelter from north wind, all well orientated. Outside spaces, orchard, covered space and café. Café, half-moon shelter and cherry tree. Café and gardens. Green spaces, communal space, cycle/walking areas. Village green, play area. Green areas. Like the whole idea, it just needs to work, be maintainable and not be too complicated. Café and garden area. Parking may be too small. Café. Café. Enclosed courtyard style.

Is there anything you are really not so keen on?

Open area shelter (encourage youths). Interior of café requires rethinking. Stone wall on covered area – visibility for vandalism. Tulloch Homes. Upkeep of SUDs basin (some doubt over SW maintaining long term). Maintenance of green areas. SUDs.

What would you like to see done differently?

Surface of overflow carpark to be used as multi-purpose court. A nursing home. Gathering space to be suitable for a band/music players etc... with no tree and electric point. Would have liked to have seen something of practical use to the community.

Are there any other features / items you would like to see within the landscape proposals?

Places for bikes. Speed restriction next to football pitch. Could 'wet foot' trees (willow and alder) be planted in the SUDs. More car parking. Consideration for elderly. Litter bins/dog bins.

Any other comments?

Electric hook-ups for motorhomes – use of toilets etc... (income generation for Culbokie). Well done CCT – amazing job as always. Well thought out in general. Fantastic asset for the village – lot of thought gone into design. More housing. Well done. Car park for people to leave their cars and take bus to Inverness or elsewhere. Thank you for all your efforts. More car parking for village use/bus/shop etc... Seems like a waste – we mostly have our own gardens and our woods – no real need for another community garden - existing green areas are underused – hall, school and church already have community access – car parking near the shop would be useful – I think this will become neglected.
