Investigations are continuing to find alternate sources of funding to support this project. SSDC have contributed some funding. A consultant who specialises in obtaining sources of funding is to used. It is hoped to commence some early works at the beginning of 2017 such as new fencing.

All comments should be forwarded to ClIr N. Begg for co-ordination and incorporation. It was noted that there an amendment is required as there is a bus service in place rom Castle Cary station. An advisor has now been lined up to help finalising the document.

• Roads and Traffic around the Parish

Ansford Parish Council has received correspondence from Highways reference the safety barriers which had previously existed which were not replaced. Current layout of the junction and latest standards and specifications were the reasons given for it not being necessary to replace the barriers.

It was noted that there is still issues with erosion and subsidence on Maggs Lane. This is to be reported to Highways.

Issues are being experienced in Clanville due to vehicles using the verges whilst passing vehicles going in the opposite direction. This is causing erosion and subsidence to the verge. Highways are currently investigating this problem and a report is expected when completed.

The Council was updated on a new Traffic Safety Group which has been set up in conjunction with Castle Cary. The group has been formed due to concerns with the speed of traffic being observed within Castle Cary and Ansford. Some of the targets of the group are: To have a 20MPH speed limit in the town and adjacent schools. o Introduction of additional SiD's in the town. The provision of additional yellow lines and a review of current parking areas. The aim of the group is 'Safer Travel for All'. The group invited Ansford Parish Council to attend future meetings. A more detailed report on the group was proposed for the next Ansford Parish Council meeting. **Ansford War Memorial** The missing paperwork on the quotation received has now been obtained. Of the three companies asked to bid only one responded. It was decided that additional quotations were required. Clerk **Existing Publicity Boards** It was noted Castle Cary have had some of their boards upgraded. Within Ansford the station board and the board adjacent St Andres church are in need of upgrading.
