

Report on Champion of Champions Competition 2019



On Sunday 22nd September the final event of the BIG League playing season took place at Caerleon P.C. and this was the Champion of Champions competition.



The teams involved were chosen from their final league positions, with the 1st and 2nd positions from divisions 1 and 2 plus the winners from divisions 3 and 4.

Thus 6 teams took part and each team was represented by 4 players playing two doubles matches in a round robin format, so 5 games for each double.

Although rain was forecast it was fairly light in the morning with only one 10 minute stoppage for a heavy shower - and the sun came out from Midday.

Although there were teams from the lower divisions, the play by all was to a high standard, and the games were all very competitive and sportsmanlike.

At the lunch break Wheatsheaf were the leaders but after lunch with the pistes drying out there was a turnaround in fortunes. All teams won games but at the end it was a close result between Caerleon A, the winners for the last two years, and Greenlawn A winners of the 3rd division.



The honours went to Greenlawn A on points countback with both teams winning 8 and losing 2 matches.

This was the first time that a team from outside division 1 has won this competition.
