1. Public Participation

2. Apologies for absence

The application to the Green Rigg Fund for Traffic Speed Reduction indicators was shortlisted but rejected "because this is a statutory obligation and is therefore outside of the criteria of the Fund."

Pot holes. Since the meeting, an email has been received from Graham Bucknall Area Highways Manager (Northern) acknowledging the problem and instructing one of his officers to "have a look at the road please with a view to possibly including in your patching works schedule". This will be reviewed at the next Parish Council meeting. **Clerk**

Signage. Since the meeting, an email has been received from the NCC Highways Programme, saying:-

"Thank you for your correspondence bringing your concerns to our attention regarding the lack of warning signage for this bad bend (at the bottom of the hill from Little Tosson to Bickerton). Your concerns have been recorded on the Directory of Requests database so that they can be considered for inclusion in a future Local Transport Plan (LTP) Programme. As you know priorities for the LTP Programme are reviewed on an annual basis and the Requests database is the starting point for the review. The prioritisation process for the LTP Programme involves consultation with

the local County Councillors and Town/Parish Councils. Issues are scored against LTP criteria and the highest 'scoring' issues are recommended for inclusion in the programme. The final draft programme is consulted on at the Local Area Councils in the first quarter of each year and the committee papers are publicly available. http://committee.northumberland.gov.uk/Meetings.aspx

The meeting referred to was held at the end of January, so this item will be on our next Local Transport Plan submission.
