

St Kilda Sat. 30th July- Fri. 5th 2011

This is a guided trip run from Mv Cuma going to St Kilda the Monach Isles and the west coast of Lewis and Harris, decisions on the destinations will be taken by the vessels skipper depending on the weather at the time. For the safety of the group decisions on where and when we paddle will be taken by myself, As a group we can discuss the various options that are available to us on the day depending on the weather and paddler ability. The Vessel leaves from Miabhaig jetty Saturday 30th early afternoon this is on the B8011 grid NB 090 344.

It would be advisable to be on the Island on Friday sometime, there are two hostels close to the ferry terminal if you are looking for accomadation Friday night. For any paddlers carrying kayaks on the ferry I can arrange to meet with a kayak trailer. If any paddlers are taking there cars over that would be helpful for transport over to the Cuma.

We will all meet up at Cuddy Point at 10am Saturday morning before departure over to the Cuma ,Cuddy Point is on the opposite side of the harbour just past the Large Castle.

The cost of the trip is £780 this includes all meals,packed lunches bedding,towels,some fruit,crisps and bottled water,any other snacks or alcohol must be taken by yourselves.
