Structure, Governance and Management

Governing Document

The Church moved to a Unitary Constitution as from 1st January 2018.

Recruitment and Appointment of Trustees

Members of the Kirk Session are the Trustees. Kirk Session members are the elders of the church and are chosen from those members of the church who are considered to have the appropriate gifts and skills.

Organisational Structure

The Kirk Session meets at least four times a year and is chaired by the Interim Moderator or an appointed Locum and is responsible for spiritual affairs within the church. Sub groups are established as required to deal with issues such as property maintenance and pastoral care. One such group submitted responses to Presbytery for the 2018 Church Review.

Objectives and Activities

The Church of Scotland is Trinitarian in doctrine, Reformed in tradition and Presbyterian in policy. It exists to glorify God and to work for the advancement of Christ's Kingdom throughout the world. As a national Church, it acknowledges a distinctive call and duty to bring the ordinances of religion to the people in every parish of Scotland through a territorial ministry. It co-operates with other Churches in various ecumenical bodies in Scotland and beyond.

Services of Worship take place every Sunday. The Sunday School would normally be run during school terms.

Trustees' Report (cont) Year ended 31 December 2021

Achievements and Performance

The Parish of Orphir and Stenness shares its minister with the linked parishes of Hoy and Walls and Flotta. Church members have taken part in most services and conduct services on days when the Minister or Locum are engaged with the other parishes. Due to Covid 19 restrictions services were held virtually by Zoom.

During most of the year the church was unable to run the weekly coffee morning meeting in the Kirk Hall to raise funds and to provide outreach to members of the community in Orphir and Stenness, but copies of the Orcadian newspaper were on sale and made a contribution to church funds. A Post Office service was provided in the Church Vestry at the same time.

Financial Review

Orphir and Stenness Parish completed the year with a surplus of £2,556 as compared with last year's £10,012. Total receipts at £18,885 compare with the previous year's figure of £25,213. Donations at £9,123 were down from £18,182. Fundraising activities yielded £1,779 compared with £5,110 the year before. The year ended with a closing balance of £54,274.

Reserves Policy

It is the Trustees' policy to hold reserves of at least six months expenditure including designated funds. At the year end the Church held unrestricted funds of £54,274 which is in line with this policy. The Trustees are aware of a number of property issues still requiring attention and the need to continue with an on-going property maintenance and improvement programme and may use some of the reserves for this purpose. Applications will be made as required to the General Trustees Consolidated Fabric Fund for money held on our behalf.

The Church holds no restricted funds.

The Church holds no endowment funds.

Statement of Trustees' Responsibilities

The Trustees must prepare financial statements which give sufficient detail to enable an appreciation of the transactions of the Church during the financial year. The Trustees are responsible for keeping proper accounting records which, on request, must reflect the financial position of the Church at that time. This must be done to ensure that the financial statements comply with the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005, the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006 and the Regulations Anent Congregational Finance approved by the General Assembly of the Church of Scotland in 2007. They are also responsible for safeguarding the assets of the Church and must take reasonable steps for the prevention and/or detection of fraud and other irregularities.

Independent Examiner's Report to the Trustees of Orphir Parish Church

I report on the accounts of the charity for the year ended 31 December 2021 which are set out on pages 7 to 11.

Respective responsibilities of trustees and examiner

The charity's trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the terms of the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 and the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006.

The charity trustees consider that the audit requirement of Regulation 10(1) (d) of the Accounts Regulations does not apply. It is my responsibility to examine the accounts as required under section 44(1) (c) of the Act and to state whether particular matters have come to my attention.

Basis of independent examiner's statement

My examination is carried out in accordance with Regulation 11 of the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006. An examination includes a review of the accounting records kept by the charity and a comparison of the accounts presented with those records. It also includes consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the accounts, and seeks explanations from the trustees concerning any such matters. The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit, and consequently I do not express an audit opinion on the view given by the accounts.
