#### **Governing Document**

The Church was administered in accordance with the terms of the Model Deed of Constitution, but has moved to a Unitary Constitution as from 1st January 2018.

#### Recruitment and Appointment of Trustees

Through 2017 Orphir and Stenness had a Model constitution. Members of the Kirk Session and Congregational Board were the charity trustees. The Kirk Session members are the elders of the church and are chosen from those members of the church who are considered to have the appropriate gifts and skills. The Interim Moderator, who is a member of the Kirk Session, is appointed by Presbytery during the period of vacancy. The Congregational Board is appointed from within the congregation and members of the congregation are invited to nominate individuals who are believed to have the skills and commitment to contribute to the management of the Church. Members are then appointed at the Stated Annual Meeting and serve for a period of three years after which they must seek reelection at the next Stated Annual Meeting.

#### **Organisational Structure**

The Congregational Board met regularly during the year. Certain responsibilities were delegated to the Property Committee as appropriate. The Kirk Session which meets at least four times a year is chaired by the Minister (Interim Moderator) or his appointed Locum and is responsible for spiritual affairs within the church.

#### **Objectives and Activities**

The Church of Scotland is Trinitarian in doctrine, Reformed in tradition and Presbyterian in policy. It exists to glorify God and to work for the advancement of Christ's Kingdom throughout the world. As a national Church, it acknowledges a distinctive call and duty to bring the ordinances of religion to the people in every parish of Scotland through a territorial ministry. It co-operates with other Churches in various ecumenical bodies in Scotland and beyond.

Services of Worship take place in the church every Sunday. The Sunday School is run during school terms.

# Trustees' Annual Report (cont) Year ended 31 December 2017

#### **Achievements and Performance**

The Parish of Orphir and Stenness shares its minister with the linked parishes of Hoy and Walls and Flotta. Church members have taken part in most services and conduct services on days when the Minister or his Locum are engaged with the other parishes. The members also run services periodically at St. Peter's Home in Stromness.

During the year the church continued to run a weekly coffee morning meeting in the Kirk Hall to raise funds and to provide outreach to all members of the community in Orphir and Stenness. Fairtrade goods and copies of the Orcadian newspaper are on sale and the event is making a significant contribution to church funds. In November there was a collection for Poppy Scotland which raised £39.50 and at Christmas a collection for the Malawi Appeal which raised £370.80. Members of the congregation again organised a Christmas Tree Festival which raised money for church funds and looks like becoming an annual event.

#### Financial Review

Orphir and Stenness Parish completed the year with a surplus of £2,675 as compared to the surplus last year of £2,660. Total receipts at £26,243 compare with the previous year's figure of £30,127. Donations at £15,751 were down by £3,306 and fundraising activities yielded £5,025 compared with £5,007 the year before. The year ended with a closing balance of £37,516.

#### **Reserves Policy**

It is the Trustees' policy to hold reserves of at least six months expenditure including designated funds. At the year end the Church held unrestricted funds of £37,516 which is in line with this policy. The Trustees are aware of a number of property issues still requiring attention and the need to continue with an on-going property maintenance programme, and may use some of the reserves for this purpose. Applications will be made as required to the General Trustees Consolidated Fabric Fund for money held on our behalf.

### Statement of Trustees' Responsibilities

### Independent Examiner's Report to the Trustees of Orphir Parish Church

I report on the accounts of the charity for the year ended 31 December 2017 which are set out on pages 7 to 11.

### Respective responsibilities of trustees and examiner

The charity's trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the terms of the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 and the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006.

The charity trustees consider that the audit requirement of Regulation 10(1) (d) of the Accounts Regulations does not apply. It is my responsibility to examine the accounts as required under section 44(1) (c) of the Act and to state whether particular matters have come to my attention.

#### Basis of independent examiner's statement

My examination is carried out in accordance with Regulation 11 of the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006. An examination includes a review of the accounting records kept by the charity and a comparison of the accounts presented with those records. It also includes consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the accounts, and seeks explanations from the trustees concerning any such matters. The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit, and consequently I do not express an audit opinion on the view given by the accounts.
