

REAL CHRISTMAS GIFTS, NOT VIRTUAL

This year's Christmas gift card appeal is now launched and the form is overleaf. The project is now in its twelfth year and has raised over £50,000 since 2009 to support frontline projects in Malawi. For those who it's new to, the concept is very simple and gives you the chance to send someone a "gift voucher" card, which will support our partner congregations in the Thyolo Highlands of Malawi. Simply choose how much you'd like to donate, fill in the form and we will send you a lovely Christmas card / certificate acknowledging the donation so you can gift it to a friend. Alternatively, we can post it directly to them saying that the donation has been made by you on their behalf. All forms must be received by Wednesday 9th December and cards will be posted on Thursday 10th December (two weeks prior to Christmas) unless you request them earlier, in which case we will send as soon as possible (from early November). If you wish to send outwith the UK please ask for the card to be delivered to yourself. If you want it to be sent to different people it would help if you could complete a separate form for each one (copies are fine)

or make the instructions very clear. Please just call the number on the back of the form if you've any queries ... and, as always - thank you very much for your continued support.
