NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2 FEES

Required fees are as follows:

Boat £6

Crew £3, *i.e. laser, 1 crew*, £9

3a SCHEDULE: Yachts

3a.1 A passage race from Stromness to St. Mary's will start at approximately 0930 on Saturday morning. Registration and a briefing will be held following arrival in St. Mary's.

3a.2 Number of races: Two afternoon races are scheduled.

3b SCHEDULE: Singlehanders

3a.1 Registration: 0930

Briefing: 1000

3a.2 Number of races:

Three morning races will be held, a longer afternoon race will be held after a break for lunch.

3a.3 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 1030.

4 THE COURSES

4.1 The passage race from Stromness will start from the slip at Ness Point, Stromness, finishing across a line between the Visitors mooring buoy and the starting signals at the end of St. Mary's pier.

4.2 The courses to be sailed will be described at the briefing.

5 SCORING

5.1 The low point scoring system will be applied to all races.

5.2 CYCA handicaps will be applied to the Yachts. No handicaps will be applied to the singlehander classes.

6 PRIZES

Prizes will be presented after the racing.

7 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

8 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2000000.
