Stromness Sailing Club 2006 Racing Results

Commodore's Bottle

On three Thursday evenings in August and on the first Thursday in September, boats competed over nine races for the Commodore's Bottle, sponsored by Stromness SC Commodore, Johnny Robertson.

The series was won by *Mercury Too*, skippered by Fred Johnston and crewed usually but not always by Arthur Sinclair. *Mercury Too* was the only boat to compete in all nine races and managed to achieve four firsts, four seconds and one third, giving her 15 points overall. This left her 33 points clear of runner up *Silver Fern*, skippered by Davie Harcus on 48 pts, quite closely followed by *Lady Midnight*, skippered by Chris Moore on 52 points. 13 August 2006 - Five skippers competed over five races

May-July Points Series

4 May 2006 - Racing cancelled because of high winds

11 May 2006- Three races (all Skipper)

18 May 2006 -Three races (Skipper/Crew/Skipper)

25 May 2006 - Three races (Skipper/Crew/Skipper)

1 June 2006 - Two races (both Skipper)

8 June 2006 - Three races (Skipper/Crew/Skipper)

15 June 2006 - Two races (Skipper/Crew)

22 June 2006 - Three races (Skipper/Crew/Skipper)

29 June 2006 - Three races (Skipper/Crew/Skipper)

6 July 2006 - Three races (Skipper/Crew/Skipper) - Revised result sheet

May Tankard Series

The May Tankard Series covers those of the scheduled Thursday evening skippers' races that are available to be sailed in May. For this series the <u>Olympic Low Point System</u> (paragraphs A4.1 and A4.2) is used.

In summary this means that:

- each boat that takes part in the series and starts and finishes any race will be given points for that race that equal its position in the race;
- any boat that takes part in the series and turns up for racing but in any race does not start (DNS), does not finish (DNF), retires after finishing (RAF) or is disqualified (DSQ) will be given for that race points equal to the number of boats that entered the series plus 1;
- any boat that joins the series part way through or who starts the series but does not turn up for racing any week will be treated as a DNS for the purposes of calculating positions and points for the races missed.

A total of 13 boats entered the May Tankard series. Therefore any boat that was indicated as DNF, DNS, RAF or DSQ in any race has been awarded 14 points for that race.

The worst single race result in the series, for each boat, is discarded. The full result of the May Tankard series are shown on the first sheet of the Cumulative Points - Skippers document.

May-July PointsSeries

The races sailed in May also count towards the May-July points series racing. For this series a different scoring system is used. This is broadly based on the old Snipe scoring system but is also used for handicap racing after times have been corrected.

- Points are awarded according to finishing position in each race
- DNS, DNF, RAF receive points for last place based on number of boats entered
- DSQ receive points for one lower than last place based on number of boats entered (eg if 8 boats entered DSQ receives the points for 9th place)
- Cumulative points are averaged over number of races sailed in series
- After averaging, a bonus of 10 points per race is awarded for each race entered subject to a maximum of 150 points in series but no bonus is awarded for any race where DSQ applies
