### **Travel**

Stirling is easily accessible by road, rail and bus. Stirling Court Hotel can be reached by a 10-minute taxi or 15-minute bus ride from the rail or bus station. There is free parking on site (permits available on request).

### **Choice of Accommodation on University of Stirling Campus**

Stirling Court Hotel: classic ensuite double bedrooms (for single or double occupancy).

OR

Willow Court (University Guest Accommodation, a 15-minute walk or short car journey from Stirling Court Hotel): ensuite rooms with small double bed (for single or double occupancy).

Accessible rooms are available in Willow Court.

Breakfast, lunch and dinner will be served in Stirling Court Hotel where there is also a bar with drinks and bar meals.

There will be both full board residential and day delegate rates available.

### **Courses**

Subject to demand we plan to run five courses. These are likely to include:

*Ancient Civilisations of Mesoamerica; Creative Writing; Exploring Poetry; Immunology: our Immune System; and The 1820 Radical Rising in Scotland.*
