### **Section 1: Mini WH for riders age 12 & under – starts 9.30am**

Class 1: Poles / peedie X-Poles, can be on lead rein / assisted

Class 2: 40cm max can be on lead rein / assisted

Class 3: 50cm max

Class 4: 60cm max

**1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> places from Classes 1 to 4 go forward to the Mini WH Championship**

### **Section 2: WH classes for all ages.**

#### **Mini riders can only do classes higher than they did in Section 1**

Class 5: Poles / X-Poles      Class 6: 40cm      Class 7: 50cm

Class 8: 60cm      Class 9: 70cm      Class 10: 80cm      Class 11: 90cm

**1<sup>st</sup> places from Classes 5 to 11 go forward to the WH Championship**

**Riders do not have to jump in their fancy dress costume, you can just put it on for the Fancy Dress judging. Once the entries are in we will publish an approx. time for this.**

### **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:**

- The Judges' decision is final.
- ORC reserves the right to change the published judge and will post any changes on FB.
- ORC has taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the Health and Safety of everyone attending. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents, and obey any instructions from the organisers and stewards
- The committee reserve the right to alter, divide or cancel any of the classes, and to transfer entries which in their opinion are in the wrong class.
- Class 1 & 2 competitors can have a leader/helper, lead reins must be attached correctly
- The same horse/rider combination can do up to 3 height classes
- All classes are open to Horses & Ponies – horse distances will apply
- To run under BRC Rules & WH Scoring. Classes will be judged 60% on jumping style & performance and 40% for conformation & show. No change of tack is permitted between jumping & showing. Boots/Bandages must be removed for the showing phase - no back boots for WH jumping.
- Hats must be to the current standard. Skull cap style hats must have a silk.
- Entry is £8 per class - Closing Date: 8pm Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> October
- Please familiarise yourselves with the new Whip Rules
- The Kitchen will be open and donations most appreciated.
- Fancy Dress is optional and can just be worn for the Fancy Dress judging
