We're delighted to welcome Ashleigh and Karen back for our Riding Club Camp.

No matter what stage you are at, there will be suitable groups for you to join and enjoy, with lots of encouragement and understanding for anyone who's a bit nervous.

Full Camp is 5 lessons over the 3 days. The ladies will be arriving off the ferry on Friday morning which means we won't be able to start lessons until 11am, and will finish at 3pm Sunday to catch the ferry. You don't have to do all 5 lessons though, you can do half-days or a mix of sessions to suit – just make sure you tell us your availability. If we get lots of bookings we may have to reduce some lessons.

For Cross Country Course you can just have a Hack round without jumping, it's your choice if you want to have a trot or canter. To jump any fences You MUST have the correct up-to-standard Body Protector and Skull Cap (not fixed peak), although a BP not essential for a hack round – you don't won't be able to do any jumps.

Lunch is for ALL camp goers and anyone else who wants to come along. All we ask is that everyone brings something savoury or sweet to share. Let us know what you are taking and what day so the food supply is spread over the 3 days. Camp is a Social Event where we enjoy sharing lunch and a blether, and even if you're not able to ride at camp, please do come along and spectate, and give us a hand in the kitchen, we'd love to see you.

To book complete the form, making sure you tick all the things you want to do, state the number of each discipline you want, and include all the details we need. If you're not coming for the full 5 lessons please write down the days / times you are available. If there's anything not on the list that you would like to do at Camp let us know and we'll see what we can do. **INHAND sessions can be arranged if enough interest**
