SUNDAY 12TH NOVEMBER, COMBINED TRAINING AND CLEAR ROUND JUMPING, INCORPORATING THE FINAL DRESSAGE LEAGUE ON THE 11TH NOVEMBER.

To round off our annual dressage league, we are planning to run a jumping phase for those that would like to (not necessary to do both, the dressage competition will be ran as normal alongside). For those wishing to jump in the combined training competition, the format will be we will take your dressage score from the Saturday (should you do more than one test we will use the score of the more advanced test), then take the penalty score from both your dressage and your jumping round to determine your placings. You are more than welcome to jump more than one round (please add all rounds to entry form) however the first round you do will be the competitive one, thereafter it will be jumped in a clear round fun format.

Classes 1 and 2 are for combinations not to have been place first to third in any jumping competition over 40cm.

Class 1 Poles and Cross Poles

Class 2 40cm - 45cm

Class 3 50cm - 55cm

Class 4 60cm – 65cm

Class 5 70cm – 80cm

Class 6 80cm – 90cm

Class 7 90cm – 1m

£5 per round maximum of 3 per horse (entries for clear round will be taken on the day at double the fee). All profit made will go to the Indoor Riding Centre.
