I refer to the above planning application and have to intimate my very strong objection to this application the following grounds, among others:

- 1) This development is likely to have an adverse effect by polluting the neighbouring residential area which has long been a smoke-free zone and damaging the health or persons living here.
- 2) We are about concerned about the increased volume of heavy vehicles and the pollution they cause through noise, fumes and damage to house foundations through vibrations and damage to road surfaces.
- 3) The application does not describe in sufficient detail whether and how waste matter will be subject to heat and what operations are in place to minimise the dispersal of the fumes arising from that process.
