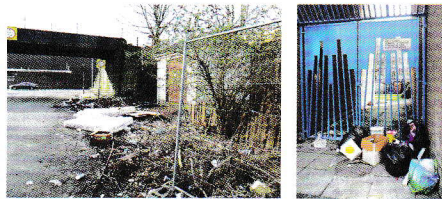

The Community Council has been dealing with issues related to Victoria Park and environmental issues affecting our local community. We are still waiting for information from the City Council on its plans for the future of the red blaes pitches in the Park. We are also saddened to report that this year's opening of the Fossil Grove is delayed due to the need for building repairs.

Local residents have informed us about how upset they are by the poor state of the streets: the constant littering; the dog fouling; the fly tipping; the damaged pavements and the blocked gulleys. Whiteinch Community Council has raised and will continue to raise

all these issues with Glasgow City Council. The street cleaning teams do their best, but often within a matter of hours, the streets are as littered as ever. We would urge everyone not leave any bulk items or other rubbish on the pathways or inshots beside homes, paint tins and wood are not uplifted. Cans, plastic bottles and paper should be recycled in in the blue bins.



We would like to start a campaign to "Love Whiteinch" so that we all treat our surroundings with the same love and care that we lavish on the inside of our homes.
