## 3 Matters arising:

- **3.1 Environmental Issues** S McLaughlin, Operations Manager, WS Estates Services gave an update on the work his team are undertaking in the local area. The group noted thanks to this team for the work they do cleaning up the area.
  - **National Flytipping Survey:** The Scottish Government public consultation on litter and flytipping in Scotland is currently open for responses until 31 March. Group agreed WCC would submit a response on behalf of the whole group. Individuals also welcome to submit response.
- **3.2 Hustings** Agreement reached at previous meeting to invite council election candidates from each political party to attend hustings within 6 weeks of election in May. Decision taken to for Whiteinch to hold their own hustings. Subgroup formed to take this forward. (M McCrae, C McGeoch, N Kelly, W Walker)
- **3.3 Victoria Park trees** Two trees were ordered but one arrived dead. Agreed to purchase a replacement. Tree planting should commence in March via Victoria Park Community Trust.
- **3.4 Climate change** Letters have been circulated to all local companies requesting copies of their green strategies.

Library has re-opened, and all encouraged to take out membership. Campaign still ongoing but will focus now on a longer-term solution. Participation request still ongoing and social media and read-in groups require further discussion. WCC again relayed thanks to the campaign group, especially E Brown for all the work and enthusiasm to reach this point.
