- 1. The speed limit on the road Stonepit Lane to Bowes Lane must be reduced from 60mph to 30mph for road safety reasons. Children will regularly need to cross the road from the new static caravan development to the main site.
- 2. Lay-bys should be created so buses can pull off the road to avoid cars overtaking buses at the bus stops.
- 3. consideration must be given to the knock on effect of the down-flow of surface water into the villages of Gristhorpe and Lebberston as flooding problems already exist.
- 4. The footpath on the plans to connect to the Cleveland Way on Bowes Lane should have a surface which is suitable for wheelchair users and prams.
