

GLENCOE OUTING FRIDAY 30TH SEPTEMBER 2016

Our annual outing this year will be a visit to scenic and haunting Glencoe.

We will start our day, after travelling either by minibus or own transport, by meeting at the Glencoe Inn, at 10.30am, for tea/coffee and shortbread. Then we make our way to the village, where we will visit the Glencoe Heritage Centre, the Glencoe Folk Museum and also the Monument.

By now it will be time for lunch so we will make our way, through the beautiful glen, to the Clachaig Inn. Unfortunately they cannot supply a fixed meal at a fixed price for us, but there is an extensive menu of light or full meals to choose from. These will be paid for individually on the day.

We will then head for our final destination, the National Trust for Scotland Visitor Centre, where you will have the chance to learn about Glencoe. We have also arranged a guided walk for those that wish it, with arrangements for the less able-bodied to join in towards the end. There will be an additional charge of £2.50 for the walk and also non-members of the National Trust will be charged a group rate of £3 per person for entry to the Visitor Centre. There is also a small café and shop. We hope to leave the Visitor Centre about 4.30pm returning to Inverness round about 7pm.

We have a 7 seater minibus available, provided by Society Member Andrew MacDonald. Priority will be given to those without their own transport. The minibus will leave the Inverness Retail Park – near the fitness centre – at 8 am.

Prices are as follows –

With minibus - £25 members/£28 non members

Own transport - £8/£10 non members

Both prices include morning coffee and museum entrance.

Additional charges on the day of £3 for non members of NTS for entry to Visitor Centre, £2.50 for everyone wishing to go on the guided walk, and of course your lunch.
