We thank you for being our good shepherd.

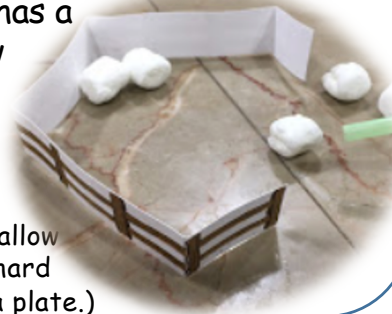
Thank you for protecting us, and guiding us, and dying on the cross so that we might be saved.

Forgive us when we don't always follow you. Keep us on the right paths and show us the way you would like us to go.

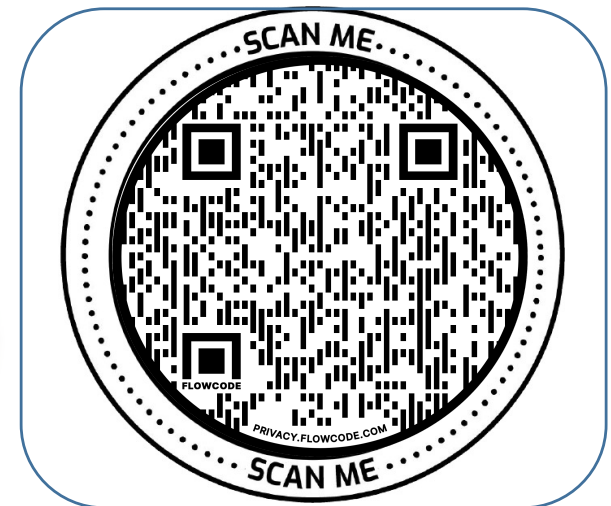
