	Clerk to contact mowing contractors requesting mowing of verges recommences in late May with strict COVID-19 protocol as laid out in contractors risk assessments being adhered to. Cllr Brown requested he now be permitted to arrange work to trees with contractor being instructed along the same lines.					
	Clerk has instructed contractor to mow whole of Recreational Field in line with Cllrs wishes as discussed on March 17 <sup>th</sup> (see notes of discussion meeting attached to these minutes).					
	Discussion took place on concerns raised about weed-killing that had been carried out throughout the village including the verges and the Green. Concerns were about environmental impact and health and safety if individuals became contaminated from using area. Cllrs were appreciative of the work but because of health and safety regulations and to ensure that BWPC is fully protected by its insurers the Clerk was directed to write to the resident explaining that such work could only be carried out on BWPC land and land/verges that the BWPC already contracts others to mow on its behalf if permission and instruction is given by BWPC, and full risk assessments and training are in place, as it has a duty of care to those using or working on such land.
