Rosamund Bartlett completed her doctorate at Oxford and has held a number of university appointments, most recently at the European University Institute in Florence, where she held a Fernand Braudel Senior Fellowship. She has expertise in Russian literature, music and art, and is the author and editor of several books, including *Tolstoy: A Russian Life*, and *Chekhov: Scenes from a Life*. She has also received recognition as a translator, having published two volumes of Chekhov's stories, and an edition of his letters, and the first new translation of *Anna Karenina* for Oxford World's Classics in nearly a hundred years.
