To Floors Castle, Kelso
on Thursday, 2nd June 2016

Floors Castle, the seat of the Duke of Roxburghe, is the largest inhabited Castle in Scotland. Built in 1721 by William Adam for the 1st Duke, it is still very much a family home, which has changed and evolved with succeeding generations. There are extensive collections of porcelain and art as well as a set of Gobelin tapestries. After lunch we will have time to explore the gardens, which include the Millennium Parterre, the Walled Gardens and Woodland walks. There is also a Gift Shop and a Plant Centre.
