3. Minutes of previous meeting

3.1 The minutes of the meeting held on 30 November which had been held over pending agreement from Elizabeth Davison were signed as correct. A letter of resignation from Elizabeth Davison to the Chairman has been received. This causes a casual vacancy to arise within the Parish Council. The Clerk updated the meeting as to the information and advice she had received from YLCA and Hambleton District Council Electoral Services. Namely that HDC will provide a notice for the noticeboard advising requests for an election. If no request has been received by HDC by the 8 May, HDC will advise the next steps after 8 May.

3.2 The minutes of the meeting of 20 February were agreed and signed as correct.

4. Matters Arising

4.1 Planning application 16/02750/Proposed detached dwelling – Rosedene, confirmation received that this has been GRANTED.

4.1 RCA confirmed that a loan defibrillator had been received and was in the box.

4.2 The clerk reported information received from the Treasurer of Bedale Community Library about the use of the Library by residents of Carthorpe. CC suggested that any amount donated to the Library be sent with the proviso that the council's budget for the year had already been set. The meeting agreed to donate a sum of £100.

4.1 Payment to YLCA for membership for the next year of £119.00 was approved.

4.2 Parish Precepts
RCA updated the meeting on information received from YLCA regarding a 2% cap on parish precepts. It was discussed that the precept next year should increase by 2% next year in order to mitigate any future caps.

4.3 The clerk updated the meeting. A form to capture new signatories had been received, which was duly completed.

5.1 The clerk advised information received from YLCA regarding planning training courses. Nobody to attend.
