



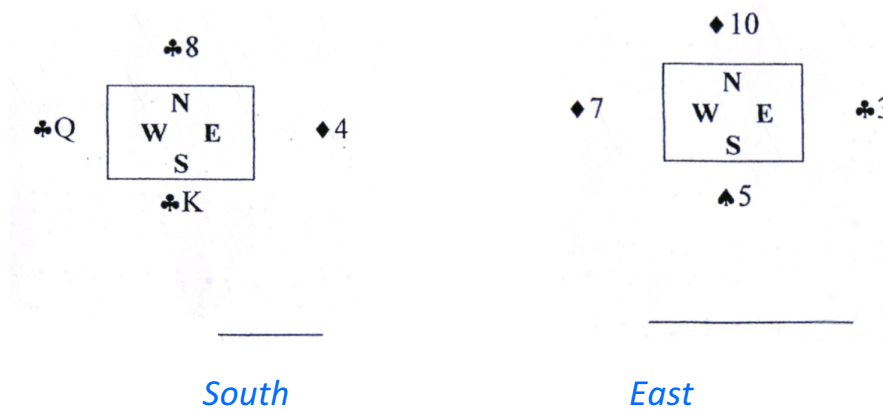

- 1 Which card is denoted by the letter “K”? *King*
And which by the letter “J”? *Jack*

- 2 Write down and the names of these cards

♠Q ♥A ♦T ♣J
Queen Spades Ace Hearts Ten Clubs Jack Diamonds

- 3 Clubs are trumps. West has just won a trick, and leads a club in the first example, and a diamond in the second example of hands below. You can see all 4 cards played. Who has won the trick in each hand?



- 4 This time we are playing the same hands but in No Trumps. Who has won this time?

5 What is the point count of these hands?
Are they balanced or unbalanced hands?

a) ♠ K Q 3

*17 HCP
Balanced*

b) ♠ A J 9 3
♥ T 8 7 6
♦ 8
♣ A K J 6

*13 HCP
Unbalanced – you have a singleton*

c) ♠ K Q 9 7 5
♥ Q J
♦ 7 3
♣ A 7 4 3

*12 HCP
Unbalanced – you have 2 doubletons*

6 Write down the order of ranking of the suits including NT

No Trumps - highest ranking

Spades

Hearts

Diamonds

Clubs lowest ranking

7 You have to choose an opening lead. What do you lead from these hands against NT contract?

♠ 5 3
♥ A K J 8 7
♦ A 7 5 3
♣ 9 2

Top of touching honours

♠ K T 9 3 2
♥ 9 6 3
♦ A 2
♣ 8 7 5
♠ 3

Low for Like

♠ 9 8 6 3
♥ Q T 8
♦ A 2
♣ 9 8 7 5
♠ 9 or ♣ 9

High for hate

8 If I win the Auction with a bid of 5 Diamonds, how many tricks does that mean I have to win to make my contract?

I contract to make 5 (that is to take 11 tricks) with Diamonds as trumps

9 What do these words mean?

a Declarer *Is the player who plays the contract*

b Responder *Is the Opening bidder's partner*

c Dummy *Is Declarer's partner. He puts his hand down on the table after the opening lead.*

d Void *Means that a hand contains no cards in a suit.*
