

# We want you to enjoy playing Bowls experience at Beaulieu Bowling

## Guidance notes...

- The **club is open** for Lawn/outdoor bowls play between Mid-End April – Mid/End September.
- **Novice players** This category is for people who have never played Bowls before or have not been playing regularly for several years and lost the knack. Contact an Office Bearer to arrange a meeting etc, see contacts section in this web site >> <http://www.spanglefish.com/beaulieybc/members.asp> or visit us on a club night (spoon night) for a chat and have a go.
- **Be Polite and Courteous.** Help others and support new and novice players at all times.
- **Clothing.** Members can wear casual clothes except for members playing in League Matches and Friendlies with visiting clubs when they should try and wear club colours or Bottle Green or White tops & Grey bottoms.
- **Lawn Care.** To avoid damaging the green, please do not bounce the bowls on the green or stand on the edges of the rinks and wear flat shoes with no heels at all times.
- **Green Availability (1).** The green will be unavailable when it is being cut which is normally twice per week, on Monday or Tuesday and Thursday or Friday mornings, for about 2hrs, but that is of course variable and weather permitting.
- **Green Availability (2).** When the club are playing home “League matches” during the match season, only 3 of the 6 rinks will be available for members use on the afternoon or evening of that day.
- **Green Availability (3).** When the club are playing home “Friendly matches” against other clubs all the rinks will be unavailable for club use on that afternoon or evening of that day.
- **Green Availability (4).** Members may play or practise anytime on their own or with a group, day or evening, except Sunday mornings, or when (1) or (3) above apply.
- **Home & Away Matches & “Friendly” matches.** A schedule/planner/calendar of matches against other clubs will be listed on the boards in the clubhouse.
- **Club Nights** (spoon nights) are every Monday, Wednesday & Friday evening at 7pm prompt, except if an occasional evening match is scheduled. Players present at 7pm are drawn randomly into groups usually between 4-6 players per rink. (£2 per evening).
- **Clubhouse Keys.** New members can have a key to the clubhouse on request. If a member resigns from the club, the key must be returned. Only the Office Bearers have keys to the Office.
- **Clubhouse access.** Occasionally the club house is used for other fundraising events such as Meetings and Entertainment outwith the Bowling club, or for club Quiz, Bingo & Race nights.  
**Personal Bowls equipment storage.** Bowls & Bags can be left in the clubhouse in the lockers provided but should not be left on the floor or chairs overnight. Please ask a committee Member for a locker key (£3).  
**Bar.** The club has a temporary private cash only bar available for club members use on some club nights & competitions etc. For other events when non-playing members are present the Club will apply for a temporary public licence as and when required.

- **Toilets.** Please leave the toilets as you find them, **clean**, and disinfect the surface's before leaving. If the disinfectant is empty, please let a committee member know immediately.
- **Match Information.** For games updates and availability for Match play etc please contact our Match Secretary.
