**46. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE** – received from Cllr C Massey.

#### **47. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST** – None.

- **48. PUBLIC FORUM** Reminder to school children and the U25s that the Holford Trust awards grants to students and it is not means tested. Contact Alison Finch, Chair of the Trust.

The Comet Bus Service has reviewed its financial position up to the end of their fiscal year 31.12.23. There will be a letter coming to the PC to request donations for the next financial year 2023/24. PC asked if the attendance is down or are the costs going up? The answer was both. Long term they need more people buying tickets even if they do not go on the bus. At the Parish Transport Reps meeting there was mention of a grant for the Oxfordshire bus service improvement plan. There is £13m for distribution in the county. There are capital and revenue schemes, and a revenue scheme might help Forest Hill.

There is a survey being undertaken along Main Street and people have asked what it is for. Cllr Bearder to find out what the survey is for. The PC thought all the utilities were being surveyed and recorded.

- **49. MINUTES OF LAST MEETING OF THE PARISH COUNCIL** held on Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> June 2023 and previously circulated. Agreed as an accurate record of the meeting and signed by the Chairman.
- **50. UPDATE ON PROGRESS FROM MINUTES OF LAST MEETING** Chairman/Clerk to report on progress of outstanding items that do not require further decision:
  - Online banking and updating Bank Mandate to add more signatories:
  - Action: AWB to look at other bank accounts
  - DW to be added as a signatory. Action: AWB and JH
  - ML to be removed as a signatory. Action: AWB and JH
  - SODC and Old Cemetery hedge and wall Action: Clerk to arrange a site meeting after 28<sup>th</sup> August with Parks Department at SODC

- Church Hill potholes stay connected with Cllr Tim Bearder for updates
- No 6, 8 and 10 Mickle Way garden fences: one house has moved the fence back but left the rubbish behind. **Action**: AWB to look at Land Registry and do a search on the boundaries.
- Stiles and Footpaths Handrail alongside steps required. The Clerk has checked the Countryside Services website, and the status is unresolved and was last updated on 22 December 2022. The status comment is: Thank you for reporting this problem. It has been logged in the database. We will follow this up in line with our priority management approach.
- 51. OCC and SODC MATTERS the 20-mph scheme an arm has been attached to one of the signs and there is another sign by Mickle Way obscured by a tree. OCC cannot maintain foliage around the signs. AWB has spoken to the owner of the tree, and it was suggested to put an arm on both signs. The PC was promised plastic signs to advertise the 20-mph scheme, but these have not materialised. Cllr Bearder will keep an eye on the Church wall issue if needed. Cllr Bearder predicts the numbers of passengers on buses will soar when cars cannot drive into Oxford. Resurfacing Church Hill this is not the worst in the division and there are no funds to do repairs. AWB asked if the work will be done properly, and a culvert needs to be made. The road is not safe for bicycles and the economic impact would improve if Oxfordshire had better roads. A member of the public reported that lorries are parking in the laybys where the toilets used to be. Cllr Bearder left the meeting at 19:25.

A member of the public asked about a baby changing station for the Baby and Toddler Group and the PC suggested they talk to the Village Hall Committee about their request.

The designated route is down Church Hill to the footpath and then onto Wheatley Park School.
