- 129. PUBLIC FORUM No members of the public were present at the forum. A question was raised during item 137 from a member of the public about LnBB (LAND NORTH OF BAYSWATER BROOK) and the land near Sandhills that has not yet been applied for planning permission. The developers are seeking outline planning permission at this stage and a public consultation was held over Christmas.
