


Look out for Youth Club dates in the next issue a meeting has been planned for May 25th when we will see the response from local families for a restart date.






News from Cubert School.

We are so fortunate to have such a supportive PTFA who work tirelessly to fund projects within the school, and thanks to them, we now have a library designed with coastal and woodland décor, mood lighting and sound effects, and it is fantastic! This is now a place where literature can be brought to life and will inspire our children's reading and story writing as they go through the school. We were delighted to have author Andrew Beasley and illustrator Rose Forshall cutting the ribbon to open the library, and inspiring the children with workshops throughout the day. Andrew's books are published by Usborne Publishing Ltd and Rose has had work published in The Guardian, The Times and Sainsburys Magazine (amongst others). Parents were invited into school (for the first time in over two years!) for the opening and to meet Rose and Andrew, and to enjoy tea and cakes kindly donated by St. Agnes Bakery. Our Year 6 pupils have been coming into school a little bit earlier this week to have breakfast together before sitting their SATS papers; this gives them the opportunity to have a chat and calm any nerves before they go into class. The children entered their tests positively and with confidence. After the tests they reported they'd done their best, and were ready to move on to their next activity of the day. It was truly inspirational and outstanding! Well done everyone in Year 6.

Thursday 26th May will be our last day before half term and so we have decided that this will be the Jubilee celebration day for the children. We will be planting a magnolia tree on the front lawn, followed by a fun packed day of activities for the children and finishing with a cream tea with homemade scones, jam and cream in the afternoon. The coming term is always a busy one with Sports Day and Transition visits to secondary schools, and this year we are planning school trips and sleepovers too now that life is almost back to normal. Towards the end of term, the PTFA are organising a Summer festival on the field. There are plans for an art competition, BBQ, bar and live music alongside activities for all to enjoy, more details to follow. We look forward to welcoming everyone on July 8th to what promises to be a lovely afternoon.






