2.0 Minutes of last meeting

3.0 Matters Arising

- 3.1 Tulloch's community contributions. Letter received. SA to reply. C/F Action: SA
- 3.2 Highland Council requests for more street names. A member of the public proposed "Downie". SA contacted HC. This exception to the normal protocol has to be justified. Biography has been drafted. To be circulated to CC members and sent to HC. C/F Action SA
- 3.3 Letter from Edward Mountain MSP: SA to invite him to meet FRCC. C/F Action: SA
- 3.4 Footpath map boards: Phil Waite (HC) has agreed to pass board's ownership to communities/other parties to improve. SA to explore option of school project to update board at 'The Plough Inn'. Action: SA
- 3.5 Crawford Avenue: Weeds, debris from cut grass and fence which requires to be repaired. Contact Highland Council. C/F Action: TH
- 3.6 Speeding between Rosemarkie & Fortrose: AP to order bin stickers for both villages; SA has enquired about moving the 'Smiley Face' speed reminder as you exit Fortrose to Avoch to as you enter from Rosemarkie. SA asked HC if they may be able to move on behalf of FRCC or FRCC can move it during erection of Christmas lights. Awaiting response. Action AP/SA

- 4.1 Janitor's House (Fortrose Academy grounds): DS to ask council what is going to happen to this now empty property. C/F Action: DS
- 4.2 Bins located by trade entrance to Co-Op. Issue raised with the CC by a resident. SA has asked Co-Op if they have given permission for this. Awaiting response. C/F Action: SA
- 4.3 Rosemarkie Cemetery: Grass is being cut regularly but cuttings not picked up, grass debris left is becoming thicker. AP contacted HC with no response. Cllr Jennifer Barclay and Cllr Craig Fraser both chasing. Action: Ward Cllrs
- 4.4 Flagpole in King George V Park: Has not been used or maintained. DS to assess condition and contact Ian Goode at High Life Highland. C/F Action: DS
- 4.5 Additional street name requested for consideration "Lackie". CC members agreed to put forward proposal. Action: SA

- 4.6 Enquiry about 'Ferry Inn' at Chanonry Point.
- 4.7 Enquiry about grit box at Gollanhead Avenue. 2 bins currently at Greenside Avenue, potential to move one. AM to check all bins. TH to investigate 'Winter Resilience Scheme' used in previous years. Action: AM/TH

8.0 Common Good Fund

- 8.1 Corner of High Street: Issue with legal services. SA to monitor. Action: SA
- 8.2 Coastal Protection status: Ward Manager working on putting together a funding package. She is to meet with Commercial Development Manager and Regional Manager and Director of Finance HC (date awaited) to discuss this. External money is essential otherwise CG will have to bear the entire cost. C/F Action: SA
- 8.3 Land opposite Rosemarkie caravan park: Ward Manager meeting with Common Good Officer within the next week and will discuss options to take this forward. C/F Action: SA
- 8.4 Academy St Picnic Area: Ward Manager has agreed to fence repair. Written quote to be submitted. Action: CC
- 8.5 Fortrose Town Hall: work in progress. Action: SA/DS. C/F to November.
- 8.6 Chanonry Point: SA met informally with Di Agnew, Bill Taylor, Ian Moncrieff & David Ogilvie (Local Area Inspector, Police Scotland) to reflect on the multiple issues over the summer. Ideas/solutions 'floated'. All require further debate. SA proposed separate FRCC closed meeting to discuss ideas/detailed proposals from Iain Moncrieff (HC). Action: SA

- 9.1 Poster for volunteers up ahead of BIG. Fortrose resident has approached SA to set up a group. There are 3 or 4 people interested and they are meeting soon. SA has put them in touch with Ward Manager. Action: SA

- 10.4 Great British Beach Clean took place on Rosemarkie Beach from 9.30am on Saturday 16th September 2017. Very well attended event.
- 10.5 Fortrose Harbour Bi-Centenary celebrations, AP to represent CC. Action: AP
- 10.6 BICC Network Agreement to continue, agenda to focus on new CC powers, changes to insurance and shared planning concerns. SA to arrange date and speaker. Action: SA
