 - 3.1 Christmas lights, tree and carols.

DG reported that the lights will be shared between the villages ensuring that two angels will be in Cathedral square. The xmas tree will

have new lights on a timer, we have permission to site the tree in the memorial garden and LT will arrange a meeting re the Carols in the cathedral.

4.1 Mackenzie portraits.

Information from New Zealand about Lord Fortrose portrait and others for sale was forwarded to ward 9 manager.

4.2 Empty Council properties /Raddery Woods AP

Future of the janitor's house at the Academy is still not known.

RAA requested a letter of support for their CAT for Mill Cottage to return it to affordable residence for a local worker. AP had declared and interest and excused herself from the decision. Members agreed to the request. GP reported that estimated costs quoted were £60.000 Raddery School and Woods - closing date for expressions of interest later this month,

4.3Rosemarkie Churchyard and clock.

Grass Cutting a THC responsibility but strimming leaves swathes of dead grass. JP reported that some areas use goats or sheep to trim grass and will find out how this works..

AP said the clock loft was open to nesting birds and was a health hazard to anyone going up. Mesh was suggested to keep birds out and enquiries to be made about resetting the chimes.

far. 30 mins wait time for the shop parking area on Rosemarkie High Street.

Station Square car park line urgently need repainting, cars parking across front blocking exit. We were told this would be done when the lines were repainted on Fortrose High Street.

We have had further requests for 20mph on Ness Road. 10.3 THC consultations.
