

ACCESS POLICY

DADCA recognises the importance of access for all members of the public, with due regard to the fire regulations and security considerations.

The principal rooms used for public events are on one floor, but with a single step down to the Struie Room, and are accessible for wheelchair & pushchair users and assisted walkers by means of one permanent and one portable ramp.

Male and Female accessible toilets are located on the main entrance floor.

Chairs are available throughout the Social Club for resting.

All written/printed information forming part of the displays, both permanent and temporary, are printed using a clear font (Arial) and in an appropriate font size to aid the visually impaired.

Free admission to events is given to carers/supporters of a disabled person.

The Committee will continue to monitor access issues by:-

- Ensuring compliance with all relevant legislation
- Assess access issues using widely available guidance checklist (e.g. internet guidance)
- Assessment of all feedback on access issues arising from visitor comments to staff/volunteers.

Security:

- Entrances to the Social Club and various rooms/cupboards within the Social Club are controlled by code number locks.
- Numbers to such locks will only be made available on a need-to-know basis.
- One or more of these codes will be changed whenever the Committee decides that they need to be.
