### Operation Paramount – Road Traffic Matters

In response to ongoing public complaints, PC's Wallace and Cook have carried out several speed gun deployments in the North East Fife area with a recent deployment at Station Road, Kingsbarns. No excessive speeds were recorded. Road Safety remains one of our top priorities in the North East Fife area, officers will continue to carry out high visibility stop points and speed gun deployments throughout the year and strive to ensure we keep your communities safe.



### COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT



PC Wallace was joined by colleagues from the Fife Coast and Countryside Trust and Safer Communities Team, attending at Kingsbarns, Wormit Bay and Balmerino and spoke with members of the public about wild camping and the responsible use of beaches. Further days of action have taken place in and around St Andrews and the surrounding areas, as well as the East Neuk. Colleagues from the Fife Coast and Countryside Trust have responsibility for the coastlines and have the knowledge and skills to provide up to date safety advice, camping advice, education and the ability to promote responsible use of the coastline and countryside. Colleagues

from the Safer Communities Team have the skills and powers to deal with anti-social behaviour including noise-nuisance legislation, littering, dog fouling and other anti-social behaviour. They can provide advice, fixed penalty notices or pass onto Police to deal with more serious incidents or repeat offenders. As Police officers we can report any offences of a more serious nature and deal with repeat offenders, as well as providing robust backing to the other partner agencies.

During the last few months we have been working closely with staff and management at the Co-op Store in Anstruther forming a great relationship with them. We have provided security advice in relation to shop layout and staffing, managing the busy periods when school children attend, carrying out visits during peak

times to educate young persons and provide a visible deterrent. We have also liaised with staff at Wade Academy providing advice and updates regarding anti-social behaviour by pupils.
