**Minutes of the Extraordinary Parish Council Meeting of North Wootton Parish Council held in the North Wootton Village Hall on Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> May 2019**

**PRESENT** Cllr S Shimmin (Chairman), Cllr K Bissett, Cllr A Bovey, Cllr M Hoddinott and Cllr M Smith.

Several members of the public were also present.

The Chairman opened the meeting at 10.00.

1. **Apologies for absence**

Apologies were received from the clerk, Ms H Brinton, who was on leave.

2. **Declarations of interest**

There were no declarations of interest.

3. **Planning Matters**

**Proposal 2019/1090/APP** – Application for approval of details reserved by conditions 3 (external walling sample panel), 4 (external schedule of finishes), 5 (hard and soft landscaping), 6 (surface water drainage system), 7 (foul drainage scheme), 9 (rooflight details on rear elevation) on planning consent 2018/1260/FUL for Foxridge, Launcherley Lane, North Wootton, Shepton Mallet, Somerset BA4 4AB

Standing orders were suspended to allow members of the public to speak on the application. There were no comments from the floor.

After standing orders had been reinstated councillors discussed the application and agreed that they supported the details provided. However, they noted that they did not feel qualified to comment on the technical content of items 6 and 7 on surface and foul water drainage.

Councillors therefore resolved unanimously that in the clerk's absence the chairman should recommend to Mendip District Council that the application should be approved but noting their inability to comment on the drainage details.

There being no further business, the Chairman closed the formal part of the meeting at 10.10.
