

## PROPOSED TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE OF HIGH STREET, SYDLING ST NICHOLAS

I have received an application from Buckland Newton Hire, to close HIGH STREET, SYDLING ST NICHOLAS from The Greyhound Inn for a distance of approximately 85 metres in a northerly direction. The closure has been requested to allow SSE to install new electric cable, Openreach to install new BT line, Wessex Water to install new foul sewer and new mains water supply in the highway. These works are programmed to commence from 19th February 2018 for 33 days with an end date of the 23rd March 2018. The road closure is necessary for safety reasons, as the works will take place within the whole width of the carriageway.

Buckland Newton Hire will publicise the road closure in a number of ways: they will place information boards on the road in this area to inform the travelling public of the works; they will carry out a letter drop to local residents directly affected by the works; and they will sign a vehicular diversion route using the local road network. The following map shows the extent of the closure and the diversion route.
